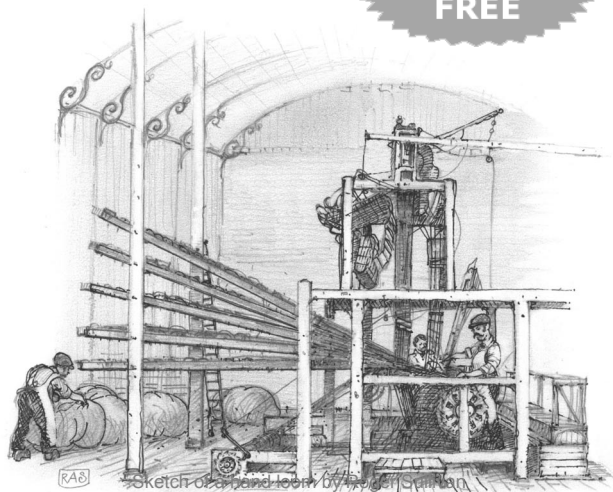

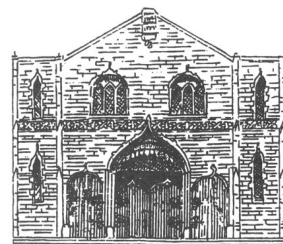
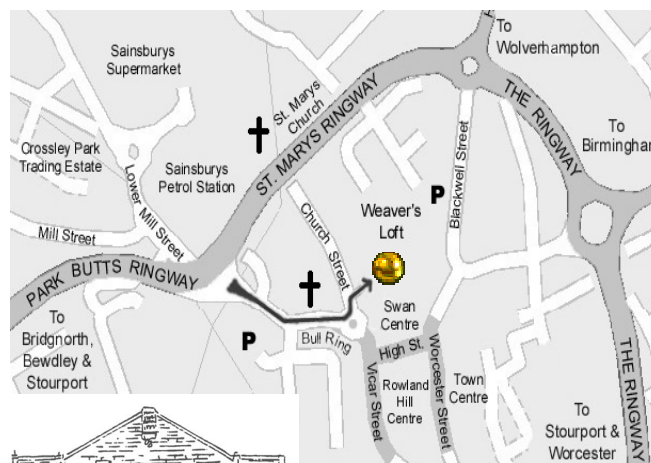


## The Weaver's Loft

The Weaver's Loft is a small display created by the Friends of the Carpet Museum Trust. The centrepiece is a working handloom set up to recreate a traditional weave.

Other exhibits include a scale model of a Brussels loom, a wooden model of the hand knotting "Turkey Work" upright loom and an accurate reproduction of a mill steam engine. Many samples depicting the range of carpets produced in Kidderminster are displayed including an 1878 Spool Axminster. Carpet designs, pictures, photographs and many more items from the Trust's extensive collection and Archives help to make a visit to the Weaver's Loft worthwhile. Come and talk to one of our volunteers about the carpet industry. Entrance is free – donations are welcome.
